### PARTICIPANTS ENGAGE WITH ONE OF FIVE LEARNING TRACKS.

- **GOVERNANCE:** Create effective and flexible structures that fulfill the promise of your mission.
- **GROWTH:** Lead to and through change, reverse declines, break through plateaus and grow beyond.
- **LIFESPAN FAITH DEVELOPMENT:** Enhance faith and action through religious education and small group ministry.
- **STEWARDSHIP:** Spark the spiritual need to give; connect individual responsibility to congregational mission.
- **WORSHIP ARTS:** Foster compelling, transcendent experiences. Extend sacred space into all activities.

**ALL TRACKS** address public witness, community outreach, social justice and aspects of small, mid-sized and large congregations.

### WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

- Lay Leaders – officers, board members, committee chairs, treasurers.
- Ministers – full-time or part-time, settled, consulting, interim and acting.
- Staff – religious educators, musicians, administrators, and coordinators.
- Teams – congregational teams and individuals from smaller congregations that form geo-based learning teams.

UULTI is a remarkable week-long residential institute. Being immersed in this learning experience for this extended period leads to a greater potential for personal transformation.

## Work as a team...

### CONGREGATIONS BENEFIT FROM COVENANTED TEAM WORK.

No matter what your congregation is like - from small to large, rural to urban, stable to transitioning, struggling to thriving, or any congregation in between, team work is a vital component of shared ministry.

Did you send a team last year? Send the same or a different team. Repeat tracks or select alternate ones. Build a critical mass of leaders who share the UULTI experience.

Individuals from smaller congregations are encouraged (by discounts!) to form geo-based learning teams.
